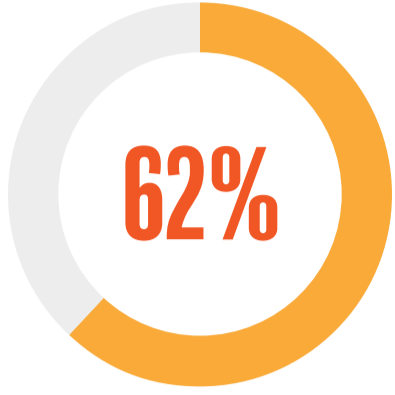

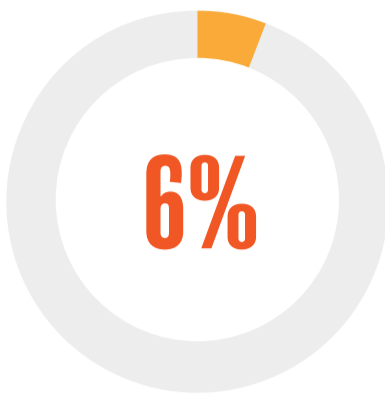

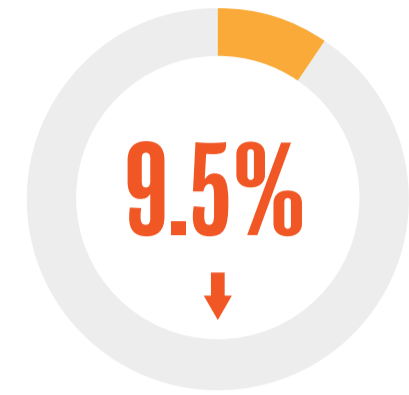

In 2012/13 the number of whiplash compensation claims fell by 9.5% from the preceding year

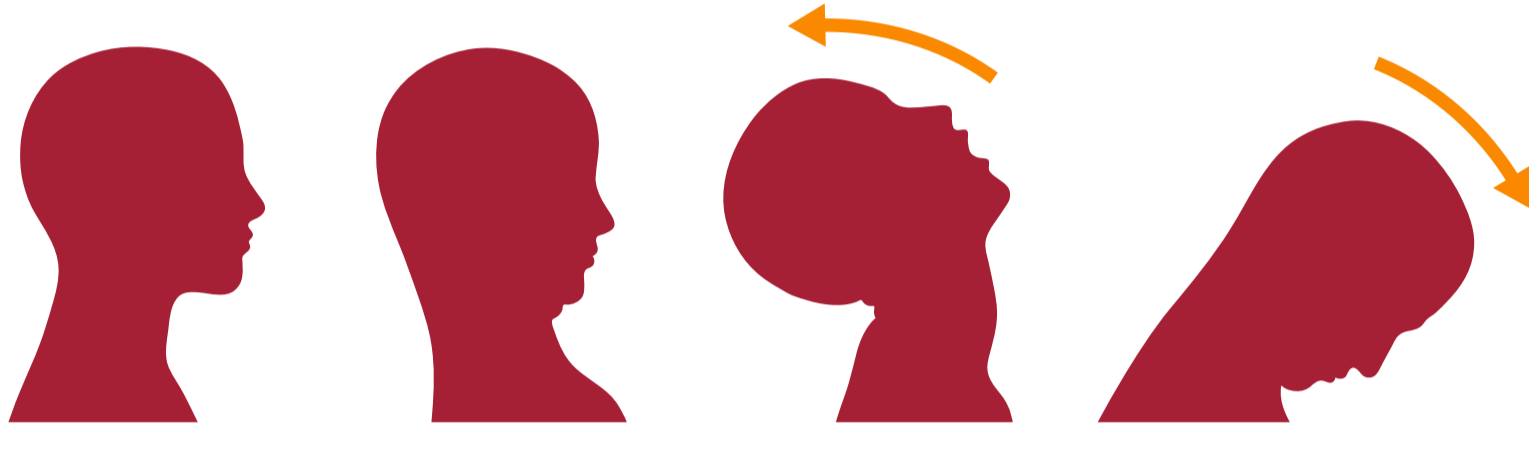

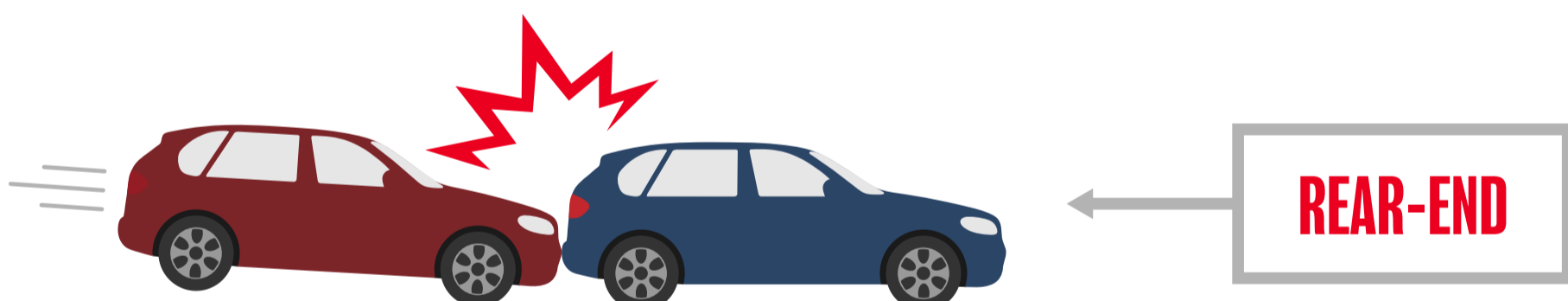

CAUSES OF WHIPLASH

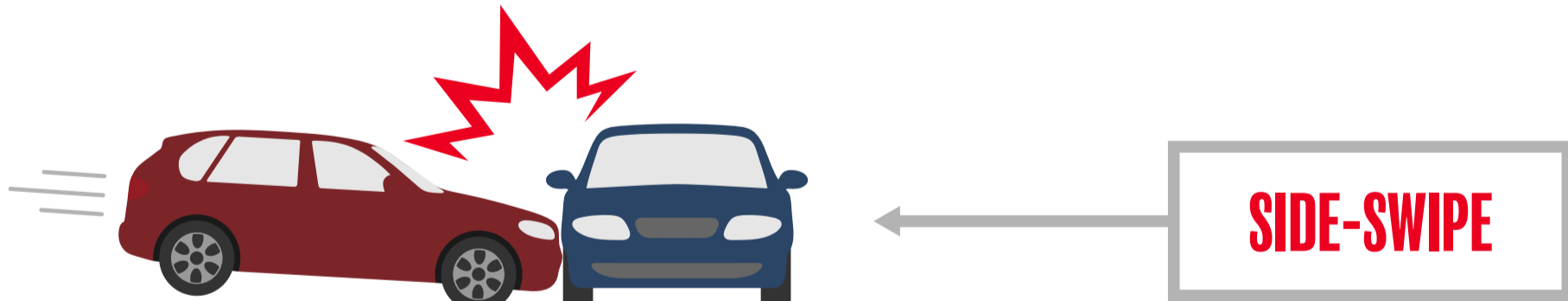
Whiplash injury can occur even in collisions that occur at speeds below 15mph as even these relatively low-impact car accidents can have serious consequences for the cervical spine.



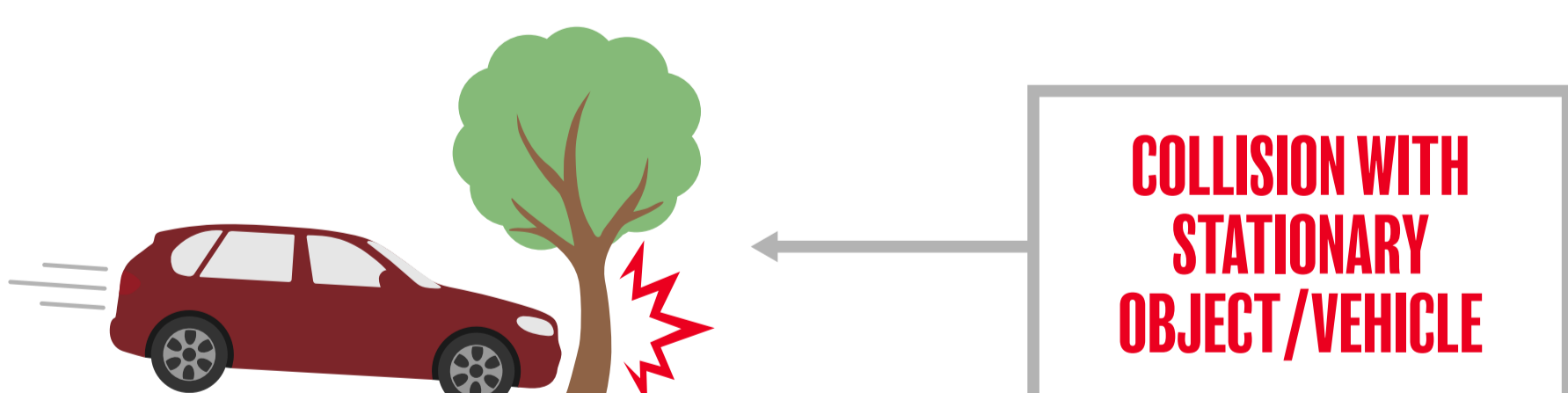
REAR-END



HEAD ON

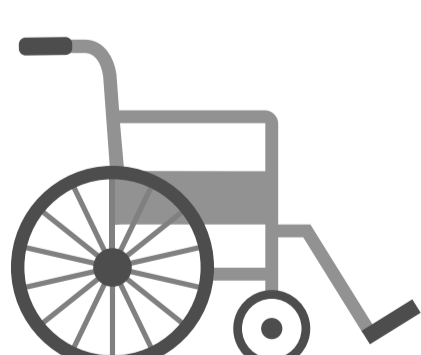


SIDE-SWIPE
